Inbreeding—The mating of closely related individuals

- Hemophilia
- Frequent appearance of autosomal/X-linked recessive disorders in pedigree

Consanguinity—Relation by descent from a common ancestor (see inbreeding)

Sex influence—Difference in expression, either in degree or in frequency, of a trait that is not X-linked

- Baldness
- · More frequent appearance/higher severity in either sex
